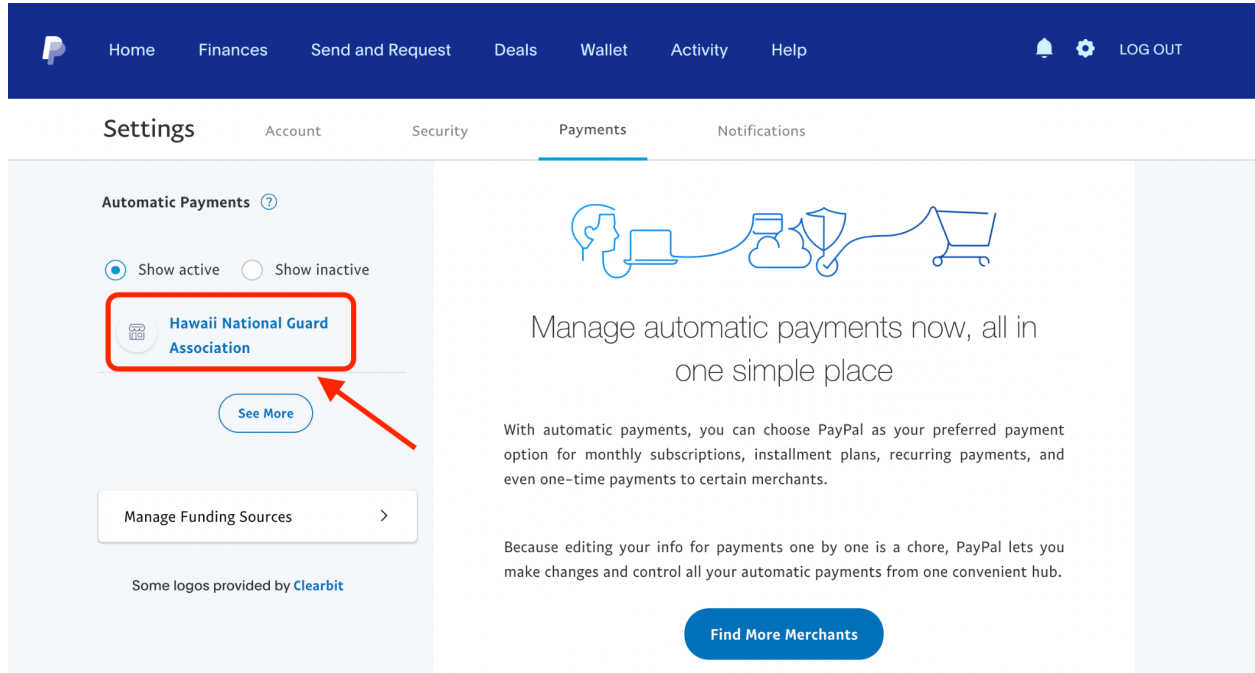


How to Cancel you Autopay in Paypal

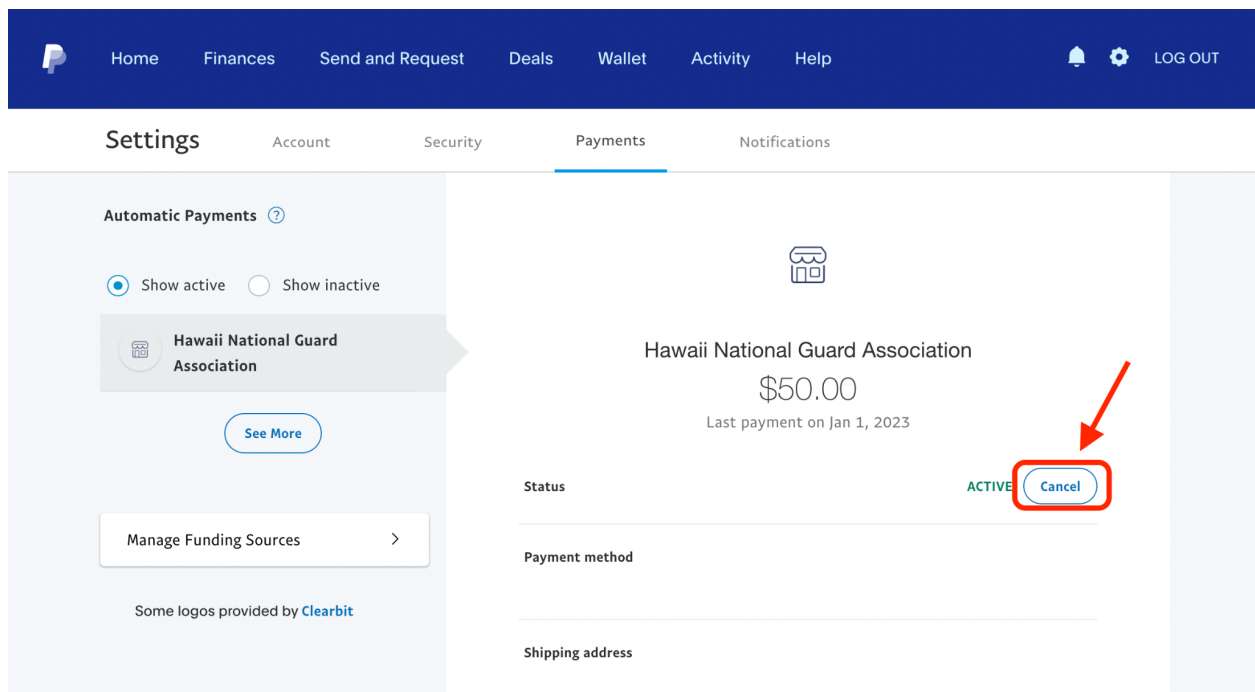
1. First, log into Paypal and go to the autopay page:

2. Next, click on the “**Hawaii National Guard Association**” hyperlink.



3. Next, click on “**Cancel**”.



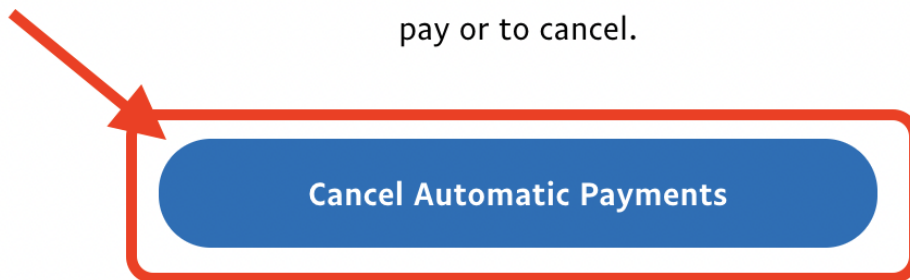
4. Next, click on “**Cancel Automatic Payments**”.
